DRAWINGS

1. GC5.01 Construction Safety and Phasing Details: Disregard the last two sentences of note 14. The number of barricades is quantified on sheet GC0.01. The contractor does not need to assume 5,000 ft. The barricades will not be turned over to the airport at the conclusion of the project.

QUESTION AND ANSWER

- **Q1.** Can you double check the quantity for the Item P-401-8.1 Asphalt Overlay quantity. According to my takeoff this quantity should be closer to 6100 ton for the 28,070 overlay area.
- **A1.** There are slight grade adjustments as part of the overlay. See addendum No 2 sheet CA5.02. The bottom lift will be +/- 2" lift. Spot elevations and/or 3d model can be provided to the winning bidder.

- **Q2.** Will it be acceptable on this project to just mill and pave 4" HMA on the overlay area or will we be required per the specifications to survey and verify grade elevations after milling and also survey between lifts of asphalt pavement and after the surface paving is done to verify grade. If so we will need the spot elevations showing the current elevations and design elevations for the asphalt areas so that we can verify them and build a model off of that data.
- A2. Please read specifications for grade requirements in section P-401 Asphalt Mix Pavement. Sections 401-5.3h and 401-6.2d help to address this question.


